**विषय: मौजूदा टैरिफ की वसूली 30.09.2026 तक जारी रखने के लिए अंतरिम व्यवस्था।**  
**Subject: Interim arrangement to levy the existing tariffs to continue till 30.09.2026.**

AERA, vide Order No. 16/2025-26 dated 18<sup>th</sup> September, 2025 inter-alia, allowed the following airports/airport operators (as per the Table – 1) to levy tariffs, on interim basis, for a period of 06 (six) months w.e.f. 01.10.2025 to 31.03.2026 or, till the determination of regular tariff for their respective control periods, whichever is earlier:

2. The Authority reviewed the position in respect of determination of regular tariffs in respect of above-mentioned airport and observed as under:

- Tariff Order for Raipur Airport has been issued.
- Consultation Paper for Trichy Airport has been issued.
- MYTP of Dehradun Airport is under examination.

3. The Authority vide Order no. 08/2025-26 dated 29.08.2025 had issued an ad hoc Order for Noida International Airport. Similarly, the Authority vide Order no. 06/2025-26 dated 20.06.2025 had issued an ad hoc Order for Navi Mumbai International Airport. These Orders were issued and to be made effective from the commercial date of operation (COD) up to 31.03.2026 or till the determination of regular tariff for their respective Control Periods, whichever is earlier. The consultation paper of Noida International Airport has been issued and MYTP of Navi Mumbai Airport is under examination.



4. Further, the existing tariff of Bangalore, Hyderabad, Cochin, Ahmedabad, Lucknow, Mangaluru, Chandigarh, Chennai, Kolkata, Pune, Goa-Dabolim, Calicut and Srinagar Airport is expiring on 31.03.2026. In this regard, MYTP of Bangalore, Hyderabad, Cochin, Ahmedabad, Lucknow, Mangaluru, Pune, Calicut & Srinagar Airport have been received from the respective airport operators and is under examination. MYTP of other airports namely Chennai, Kolkata, Chandigarh and Goa-Dabolim are awaited from the concerned airport operator.

5. In view of the above, the Authority decides to extend the existing tariff, as applicable as on 31.03.2026, for a period of 06 months i.e. w.e.f. 01.04.2026 to 30.09.2026 or till the determination of regular tariff for their respective control periods, whichever is earlier. In respect of airports/airport operators as given in Table 2 below:

## ORDER


Upon careful consideration of the material available on records, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1)(a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, hereby orders that:

- (i) The **Airport Operators listed at Table-2** above are allowed to levy the existing tariff, applicable as on 31.03.2026, on interim basis, for a further period of 06 (six) months w.e.f. 01.04.2026 to 30.09.2026 or till the determination of regular tariff for their respective Control Period, whichever is earlier.
- (ii) The Airport Operators shall ensure compliance of the Order.
